The 61 duplexes were originally built in 1962 and 1963 to house military families from Nellis A.F.B.

In 1986, all units received extensive rehabilitation and continue to provide affordable housing to low income families today.

The property was named in honor of William Brown, former Chairman of the Board of Commissioners during the early 1960's.

The “**streets**” in the area are named in honor of the Commissioners who were serving at that time.

Harve “**Perry**”, owner of a men’s shop in Henderson;
Bill “**Byrne**”, Mayor of Henderson; “**Van**” Englestead and
Harold “**Baldwin**”, Henderson Postmaster.

James “**Farndale**”, served as Executive Director from 1948 – 1963.

The single-story units feature air conditioning, carpeting, large dual-pane windows, laundry hook-ups, outside drying areas, mature landscaping and plenty of parking.

Located adjacent to the property and in Miller Plaza are playgrounds, a Head Start facility, EOB Community Resource Center in the Kaufman Center, and the Henderson Boys and Girls Club at the Twitchell Center.

This very convenient, eastside location is within walking distance to many shopping centers, grocery stores, banks, schools, and bus routes. This property is just east of Nellis on Flamingo Road behind Sam’s Town.
